Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Subpart B implements Sections 112(g)(2)(B) and (j) of the Clean Air Act: (1) Section 112(g)(2)(B) (i) Requires new or reconstructed Major Sources of hazardous air pollutants to apply case-by-case maximum achievable control technology (MACT), if no NESHAP applies (2) Section 112(j) (i) Requires Major Sources of Hazardous Air Pollutants to obtain a Title V operating permit with case-by-case MACT requirements, if they are within a listed source category where EPA was required to promulgate a standard and no standard exists
