Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Industrial process cooling towers that are operated with chromium-based water treatment chemicals and are either Major Sources or located at Major Sources of HAPs* "Chromium-based water treatment chemicals" means any combination of chemicals containing chromium used to treat water. *Major Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (A) ≥ 10 tons/year of any single HAP; or (B) ≥ 25 tons/year of total HAPs. Area Sources emit less than Major Sources
