This subpart applies to: (A) Individual batch vapor, in-line vapor, in-line cold, and batch cold solvent cleaning machines that use any of the following in a total concentration greater than 5% by weight (1) Methylene Chloride (CAS No. 75-09-2); (2) Perchloroethylene (CAS No. 127-18-4); (3) Trichloroethylene (CAS No. 79-01-6); (4) 1,1,1-Trichloroethane (CAS No. 71-55-6); (5) Carbon Tetrachloride (CAS No. 56-23-5); (6) Chloroform (CAS No. 67-66-3). (B) Source Classification (1) Existing source = installed on or before 11/29/1993 (2) New source = installed after 11/29/1993
