Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Manufacturers of basic liquid epoxy resins (BLR) and manufacturers of wet strength resins (WSR) that are located at a plant site that is a major source. II. Exempt from this subpart: (A) Research and development facilities *Major Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) ≥ 10 tons/year of any single HAP; or (2) ≥ 25 tons/year of total HAPs. Area Sources emit less than Major Sources.
