Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Any of the following affected sources at secondary lead smelters: (1) Blast, reverberatory, rotary, and electric furnaces; (2) Refining kettles; (3) Agglomerating furnaces; (4) Dryers; (5) Process fugitive emission sources; (6) Buildings containing lead-bearing materials; (7) Fugitive dust sources. II. Exempt from this subpart: (A) Primary lead processors (B) Lead refiners (C) Lead remelters Definition of "Secondary Lead Smelter" Any facility at which lead-bearing scrap material, such as lead- acid batteries, is recycled into elemental lead or lead alloys by smelting.
