Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Affected sources at phosphate fertilizer production plants that are Major Sources of HAPs*. (B) Affected sources: (1) Phosphate fertilizer process lines (e.g. diammonium and/or monoammonium phosphate process lines); (2) Granular triple superphosphate process lines; (3) Granular triple superphosphate storage buildings; (4) Evaporative cooling towers. II. Not subject to this subpart: (A) Research and development facilities. *Major Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) ≥ 10 tons/year of any single HAP; or (2) ≥ 25 tons/year of total HAPs. Area Sources emit less than Major Sources.
