Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Magnetic tape manufacturing operations located at Major Sources of HAPs*. (B) Magnetic tape manufacturing operations which choose to use the provisions of §63.703(b) and (h) to obtain a federally enforceable limit to its potential to emit HAP. *Major Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) ≥ 10 tons/year of any single HAP; or (2) ≥ 25 tons/year of total HAPs. Area Sources emit less than Major Sources II. Not subject to this subpart: (A) Research or laboratory facilities; (B) Any coating operation that produces a quantity of magnetic tape that is 1% or less of total production (in terms of total square footage coated) during any 12-month period.
