Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Facilities engaged, in part or in whole, in the manufacture of wood furniture or wood furniture components and located at a Major Source of HAPs*. II. Not subject to this subpart: (A) Research or laboratory facilities; (B) Surface coating of metal parts and products (other than metal components of wood furniture) subject to NESHAP MMMM; (C) Surface coating of plastic parts and products (other than plastic components of wood furniture) subject to NESHAP PPPP; (D) Surface coating of wood building products subject to NESHAP QQQQ; (E) Surface coating of metal furniture subject to NESHAP RRRR. *Major Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) ≥ 10 tons/year of any single HAP; or (2) ≥ 25 tons/year of total HAPs. Area Sources emit less than Major Sources.
