Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Major Sources of HAPs* that operate publication rotogravure, product and packaging rotogravure, or wide-web flexographic printing presses *Major Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) ≥ 10 tons/year of any single HAP; or (2) ≥ 25 tons/year of total HAPs. Area Sources emit less than Major Sources. II. Partial Exemptions: (A) Major Sources that commit to limits that reduce their HAP emissions are subject only to reporting and recordkeeping requirements. (1) Use < 9.1 Mg (10 tons) per each rolling 12-month period of each HAP at the facility. (2) Use < 22.7 Mg (25 tons) per each rolling 12-month period of any combination of HAP at the facility.
