Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Pesticide active ingredient manufacturing process units (PAI process units), located at Major Sources of HAPs*, that process, use or produce HAP, and associated equipment. (B) Associated equipment: (1) Waste management units; (2) Heat exchange systems; (3) Cooling towers. *Major Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) ≥ 10 tons/year of any single HAP; or (2) ≥ 25 tons/year of total HAPs Area Sources emit less than Major Sources. II. Not subject to this subpart: (A) Research and development facilities; (B) PAI process units that are subject to NESHAP F; (C) Ethylene production; (D) Coal tar distillation; (E) Stormwater from segregated sewers;

	(F) Water from fire-fighting and deluge systems, including testing of such systems (G) Spills; (H) Water from safety showers; (I) Noncontact steam boiler blowdown and condensate; (J) Laundry water; (K) Vessels storing material that contains no organic HAP or contains organic HAP as impurities only; (L) Equipment intended to operate in organic HAP service for less than 300 hours per calendar year.
