Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Facilities engaged in producing lead metal from ore concentrates that are Major or Area Source of HAPs* II. Not subject to this subpart: (A) Secondary lead smelters; (B) Lead refiners; (C) Lead remelters. *Major Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) ≥ 10 tons/year of any single HAP; or (2) ≥ 25 tons/year of total HAPs. Area Sources emit less than Major Sources.
