Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) You if you own or operate a new, reconstructed, or existing affected major source in which you choose to include any coating operations which apply coatings to: (1) New other motor vehicle bodies or body parts for new other motor vehicles; (2) Parts intended for use in new automobiles, new light-duty trucks, or new other motor vehicles; (3) Aftermarket repair or replacement parts for automobiles, light-duty trucks, or other motor vehicles
