Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Applies to area sources* of HAP that produce copper scrap in a blast furnace and converter or use another pyrometallurgical purification process to produce anode copper from copper scrap, including low-grade copper scrap *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) < 10 tons per year of any single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs
