Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) New and existing industrial, commercial, and institutional boilers located at Area Sources of HAPs (hazardous air pollutants) * *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) < 10 tons per year of a single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs. Major Sources emit more than Area Sources. II. Not Subject to this Subpart: (A) Gas-fired, electric, residential, and temporary boilers (B) Boilers used specifically for research and development (C) Hot water heaters (D) Hazardous waste boilers covered under NESHAP Subpart EEE or section 3005 of the Solid Waste Disposal Act (E) Electric utility steam-generating units covered under NESHAP Subpart UUUUU
