Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) area sources* of HAP that produce chromium compounds, principally sodium dichromate, chromic acid, and chromic oxide, from chromite ore. *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) < 10 tons per year of a single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs. Major Sources emit more than Area Sources
