Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Area sources that manufacture lead acid storage batteries made from lead alloy ingots and lead oxide. *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) < 10 tons per year of a single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs. Major Sources emit more than Area Sources.
