Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Owners or operators of wood preserving operations that are Area Sources* of HAPs. (B) Definition of "Wood Preserving": (1) The pressure or thermal impregnation of chemicals into wood to provide effective long-term resistance to attack by fungi, bacteria, insects, and marine borers. *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) < 10 tons per year of a single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs. Major Sources emit more than Area Sources
