Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Applies to an area source* of hazardous air pollutants (HAP) that is a glass manufacturing facility with specific specifications. *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) < 10 tons per year of a single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs. Major Sources emit more than Area Sources.
