Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Applies to plating and polishing facilities that are area sources* of HAP and that use or emit any compounds of cadmium, chromium, lead, manganese, or nickel *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit (1) < 10 tons per year of a single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs. Major Sources emit more than Area Sources
