Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) New and existing chemical preparation at area sources of HAP* with mixing, blending, milling, and extruding operations to manufacture chemical preparations. Chemical preparation means a target HAP- containing product, or intermediate used in manufacturing other products, manufactured in a process described by NAICS code 325998 if the operation manufactures target HAP-containing products. (B) Target HAPs are: Chromium (IV), lead, and nickel $\geq$ 0.1% by weight and Chromium (III) and manganese $\geq$ 1.0% by weight II. Not Subject to this Subpart: (A) Manufacturing of indelible ink, India ink, writing ink, and stamp pad ink or sources subject to 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart VVVVVV or CCCCCC *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) < 10 tons per year of a single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs.
