Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Gold mine ore processing and production facilities that are area sources* of hazardous air pollutants (HAP). *Area Sources of HAPs emit or have the potential to emit: (1) < 10 tons per year of any single HAP, or (2) < 25 tons per year of combined HAPs.
