Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. The purpose of this appendix is to: (A) Define the procedures for an owner or operator to use to calculate the site-specific fraction of organic compounds biodegraded (F_{bio}) in a biological treatment unit. If an acceptable level of organic compounds is destroyed rather than emitted to the air or remaining in the effluent, the biological treatment unit may be used to comply with the applicable treatment requirements without the unit being covered and vented through a closed vent system to an air pollution control device.
