Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Petroleum liquids storage vessels with a capacity of more than 40,000 gallons (151,412 liters) that commence construction or modification: (1) Commences construction or modification after March 8, 1974, and prior to May 19, 1978 (If > 40,000 and ≤65,000 gallons) (2) After June 11, 1973, and before May 19, 1978 (If > 65,000 gallons) (B) Storage vessels constructed, reconstructed, or modified after May 19, 1978, or July 23, 1984, are subject to NSPS Ka or Kb, respectively II. Not subject to this subpart: (A) Storage vessels used for petroleum or condensate stored, processed, and/or treated at a drilling and production facility prior to custody transfer

	III. Important Distinction: (A) Petroleum liquids means petroleum, condensate, and any finished or intermediate products manufactured in a petroleum refinery but does not mean #'s 2 through 6 fuel oils as specified in ASTM D396-78, 89, 90, 92, 96, or 98, gas turbine fuel oils #'s 2-GT through 4-GT as specified in ASTM D2880-78 or 96, or diesel fuel oils #'s 2-D and 4-D as specified in ASTM D975-78, 96, or 98a
