Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Storage vessels with a capacity ≥ 75 cubic meters (m^3) (19,812.90 gal) used to store volatile organic liquids (VOL), which commenced construction, modification, or reconstruction after October 4, 2023 II. Not subject to this subpart: (A) Vessels at coke oven by-product plants (B) Pressure vessels designed to operate in excess of 29.7 pounds per square inch absolute (psia) (204.9 kilopascals (kPa) absolute) and without emissions to the atmosphere; (C) Vessels permanently attached to mobile vehicles such as trucks, railcars, barges, or ships; (D) Vessels with a design capacity less than or equal to 420,000 gal (1,589.874 m^3) used for petroleum or condensate stored, processed, or treated prior to custody transfer; (E) Vessels located at bulk gasoline plants as defined in <u>40 CFR 63.11100</u>; (F) Vessels located at gasoline service stations; (G) Vessels used to store beverage alcohol; or (H) Vessels that only store VOL with a maximum true vapor pressure less than 0.25 psia (1.7 kPa absolute)
