Am I Subject to this subpart?	I. This subpart applies to: (A) Affected facilities at mineral processing plants that commence construction, modification, or reconstruction after April 23, 1986 (B) Affected facilities: (1) Calciners; (2) Dryers. (C) For the brick and related clay products industry, only the calcining and drying of raw materials prior to firing of the brick are covered II. Not subject to this subpart: (A) Affected facilities subject to <u>NSPS LL</u> ; (B) Vertical shaft kilns in the magnesium compound industry; (C) Chlorination-oxidation processes in the titanium oxide industry; (D) Coating kilns, mixers, and aerators in the roofing granules industry; (E) Tunnel kilns, tunnel dryers, apron dryers, and grinding equipment that also dries process material in any of the 17 mineral industries (per 40 CFR 60.731)
