This subpart applies to: (A) Note: Sources subject to this rule are now subject to 40 CFR 62 OOO Federal Plan requirements (B) Municipal solid waste (MSW) landfills that commence construction, modification, or reconstruction on or after May 30, 1991 (C) Physical or operational changes made to an existing MSW landfill solely to comply with NSPS Cc are not considered construction, modifications, or reconstruction (D) Activities required by or conducted pursuant to a CERCLA, RCRA, or State remedial action are not considered construction, modifications, or reconstruction
