This subpart applies to: (A) Facilities that commenced construction, modification or reconstruction on or before December 6, 2022, must submit a state or tribal plan that implements the emission guidelines (B) If no designated facilities which construction commenced on or before December 6, 2022, must submit a negative declaration (C) Must submit plan or negative declaration by March 9, 2026
