Am I Subject to this Appendix?	I. This appendix applies to: (A) Evaluating the effectiveness of quality control (QC) and quality assurance (QA) procedures and the quality of data produced by any continuous emission monitoring system (CEMS) that is used for determining compliance with the emission standards on a continuous basis as specified in the applicable regulation. The CEMS may include pollutant (e.g., SO ₂ and NO _x) and diluent (e.g., O ₂ or CO ₂) monitors.
