ORDER GRANTING PERMIT TO DRILL A WATER WELL

WITHOUT REGARD TO MINIMUM STATUTORY SPACING

The Chief Water Officer of the Department of Water, Energy and Environment (Department) approves Application WSP-135, for a permit to drill an industrial supply well within 1,000 feet of existing public water supply well G-030666B, submitted by Brian Johnson with on behalf of Country Partners Cooperative (Applicant).

The terms and conditions of permit WSP-135 are as follows:

1. The existing industrial supply well, located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 25, Township 18 North, Range 13 West of the 6th P.M. in Valley County, shall be properly registered pursuant to the requirements of *Neb. Rev. Stat.* § 46-602(1).
2. Approval of this permit is based on the information included and representations made in Application WSP-135 by Country Partners Cooperative. That information and those representations are considered terms of this approval, to which the applicant must adhere.
3. The well shall be operated in compliance with all Nebraska statutes and all rules and regulations promulgated by the Lower Loup Natural Resources District.
4. Issuance of this permit does not relieve the Applicant from any future damages associated with the spacing violation that is the subject of this Order.

THIS PERMIT MAY BE REVOKED OR MODIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT.
