

Completing This Form

The *Lead and Copper Results Report* ("Form 5") is designed to meet all reporting requirements of the Lead and Copper Rule ("LCR"). Water systems are required to submit the results of all tap samples for lead and copper, including the location of each site and criteria. Additionally, the water system must also report the 90th percentile concentrations for both lead and copper.

To meet the requirements of LCR, please read the instructions carefully and fill out all information on the back of this form.

Calculating the 90th Percentile

1. Place all **lead** results in the "Lead Results" column in ascending order (i.e., the sample with the lowest lead result at the bottom, and the sample with the highest lead result at the top).
 - o Each lead result is assigned a number. The **lowest** lead result is placed in **Row 1**. The number assigned with the highest lead result must be equal to the total number of samples taken.
2. The number of samples taken during the monitoring period is multiplied by 0.9.
 - o **Example.** A system collected 10 samples $\times 0.9 = 9$.
The 90th percentile will be the 9th highest result for both lead and copper.
3. A system that collects only five samples per monitoring period must calculate the 90th percentile by averaging the highest and second highest result.
4. Repeat these steps for all **copper** results collected by the system.
