ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-11306

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-11306 is held by **David L. and Quana K. Laursen.**
2. Appropriation A-11306 with a priority date of **January 8, 1968,** authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the **118.8 acres** of land described below. The water may be diverted from **the Elkhorn River** at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the **SW¹/₄** of **Section 32, Township 29 North, Range 11 West of the 6th P.M. in Holt County.** The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every **70 acres** irrigated at a maximum combined rate of **1.70 cfs** from all points of diversion.

3. The Department has received information concerning the use of surface water appropriation A-11306 that indicates the appropriation has not been used for its required purpose for more than five consecutive years.
4. On February 25, 2026, the Department issued a Notice of Preliminary Determination of Nonuse of appropriation A-11306. The Notice was delivered by certified mail to David L. and Quana K. Laursen, 49375 Highway 20, O'Neill, Nebraska 68763.
5. No contest of the Preliminary Determination of Nonuse was received in the Department.
6. The Department has determined that appropriation A-11306 has not been used for its required purpose for more than five consecutive years.
7. Nebraska Revised Statutes § 46-229.02 provides that an appropriation not used for a beneficial purpose for more than five consecutive years may be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-11306 is **CANCELLED**.
