ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-15771

WATER DIVISION 1-F

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-15771 is held by the Patricia A. Kavanaugh Revocable Living Trust.
2. Appropriation A-15771 has a priority date of February 20, 1981, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 40 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the South Fork of the Little Nemaha River at a point of diversion located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 01, Township 06 North, Range 11 East of the 6th P.M. in Johnson County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.57 cfs.

Kavanaugh Revocable Living Trust, filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-11578, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-15771 for use upon the land described above.
