**APPROVAL OF PETITION VAR-11908 FOR LEAVE TO FILE AN APPLICATION
FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER**

WATER DIVISION 2-D

BACKGROUND

1. On November 3, 2004, the Department of Natural Resources (Department) issued a formal moratorium on all new surface water appropriations in portions of the Upper Niobrara White Natural Resources District (UNWNRD). The moratorium included the Niobrara River Basin above the Mirage Flats diversion dam.
2. The Department's November 3, 2004, Order and the provisions of *Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-714(3)(n)* allow for new surface water appropriations and increases in irrigated acres if the Department grants a variance and subsequently approves a permit for such new use.
3. On May 21, 2026, Amanda Gehrt, on behalf of the United States Forest Service (Petitioner), filed Petition VAR-11908 for Leave to File an Application for a Permit to Appropriate Water. The proposed application is for a **permit** to store **40.1 acre-feet of water** in **Boardgate Reservoir** for the purpose of **stock water, fire protection, and recreation** from a **tributary to Big Cottonwood Creek** at a point of diversion located in the **SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$** of **Section 19, Township 34 North, Range 52 West of the 6th P.M. in Dawes County.**
4. When filing a variance request, a project proponent must offer a clearly stated basis for such request and must offer sufficient good cause shown. *Department of Natural Resources Rules for Surface Water, Title 457 Neb. Admin. Code Chapter 23* lists six circumstances that may be put forward as justification for granting a variance to apply for new water use, in conjunction with an examination of good cause shown.

CONCLUSIONS

1. The dam that holds water in Boardgate Reservoir is shown on aerial imagery taken in 1974, and existed prior to the formal moratorium.
2. The proposed application is for a dam rehabilitation project. The Petitioner asserts that water use is a necessary component of the construction project which addresses a public safety issue.
3. For these reasons, Petitioner should be granted leave to file an application for a permit to appropriate water.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Petition VAR-11908 for Leave to File an Application for a Permit to Appropriate Water is **GRANTED**.
2. This Order granting leave to file or consider an application for a new surface water appropriation within a moratorium or stay area pursuant to petition VAR-11908 shall be in effect for **one year** from the date this order is signed.
3. This decision shall not bind the Department to approve any application to which it relates, or in any way be used as evidence of prejudice for future decisions concerning the specific approval requirements of such an application.
