**NOTICE OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION OF NONUSE  
OF SURFACE WATER APPROPRIATION A-10819**

WATER DIVISION 2-B

1. Records on file in the Department of Water, Energy, and Environment (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-10819 is held by **Terry L. and Norma L. James, Co-Trustees of The James Family Revocable Trust.**
2. Appropriation A-10819 has a priority date of **March 29, 1966**, and authorizes use of water for irrigation on **7.8 acres**, described below. Water may be diverted from **Buffalo Creek** at points of diversion **in the N<sup>2</sup>NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 26, Township 24 North, Range 04 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Madison County.** The maximum diversion rate shall not exceed **0.11 cubic feet** per second (cfs).

3. Based on information received and records reviewed, the Department has determined that Appropriation A-10819 has not been used for irrigation for **more than five consecutive years**, as required by Nebraska law.
4. At this time, the Department is unaware of any sufficient cause for nonuse under **Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.04**.
5. Pursuant to **Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-229.02**, this Notice serves as preliminary notification that Appropriation A-10819 will be **cancelled** unless this determination is successfully contested.
6. Landowners with a legal interest in the land under this appropriation may:
  - A. Take no action. If no response is received by the deadline, the Department will proceed with cancellation of Appropriation A-10819.
  - B. Contest this determination by submitting the enclosed **contest form** to the Department's Lincoln office (245 Fallbrook Blvd., Suite 100, Lincoln, NE 68521) **by 5:00 P.M. on July 6, 2026. No filing fee is required.**
